

## **JOB DESCRIPTION**

**Position:** Campus Production Technician

**Location:** Central Services – All Campus Locations

### **Overview**

The Campus Production Technician is responsible for executing production support for all campuses. This role will be involved with a variety of technical disciplines and will strongly influence the various ministries and volunteer teams throughout the church.

We are looking for someone with the ability to understand the entirety of the Production Department's scope and implement it in specific areas. This role will require strong task-management skills to continually evaluate services and their translation to our campuses. The Campus Production Technician (CTD) will be part of the Production team and report to the Campus Technical Director.

### **Personal Responsibilities**

- Be committed to grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ (2 Peter 3:18; 1 Peter 2:2) by assembling for instruction in God's Word and engaging in the personal study of God's Word.
- Responsibly use the resources at your disposal to foster the mission and vision of Abundant Life (1 Peter 5:1-4).
- Participate in an Abundant Life group (Acts 2:41-42) as well as the discipleship ministry (Matthew 28:18-20).
- Live in a way that glorifies God and aligns with the staff core values (1 Timothy 3:1-7, Titus 1:5-9).
- Be committed to giving to the needs of the saints (2 Corinthians 8:1-7 & 9:12).

### **Essential Functions and Responsibilities**

- Ensure that all campus production equipment is maintained and managed.
- Develop a long-term sustainable workflow for staff and volunteers to maintain equipment.
- Act as the primary contact for campus production needs during Weekend Services, floating at each campus as needed.
- Work with ministry heads and CTD to continue meeting ministry needs at individual campuses.
- Maintain a working knowledge of new technologies within the industry to assist in further ministry development.
- Enlist, train, and develop leaders for the Production Department of Abundant Life.
- Attend weekly meetings with various leadership teams.
- Oversee the weekly execution of live stream to campuses.
- Work with CTD to prepare an annual budget for approval.
- Oversee the execution of the budget with oversight by CTD.
- Perform other duties as requested by the Executive Pastor of Worship or CTD.

### **Skills and Qualifications**

This position requires a spiritual leader who is called to production and has a servant's heart. They must also be team player who is motivated to strive for excellence in all things. Success in this role demands someone that is a high-caliber leader of volunteers who values relationships and uses effective communication skills to teach, inspire, motivate, and mentor others. The Production Technician must be highly organized with the ability to be task-oriented and hit deadlines on a consistent basis.

Above all, AL relies heavily on the embodiment of the Staff Core Values in all areas of the ministry to support our mission of seeing lives changed by Jesus and our vision of being living proof of a loving God to a watching world. The essential functions and responsibilities listed are representative of the position but are not intended to be all-inclusive of the traits needed to perform the job.

- Advanced understanding of audio and video signal flow.
- Solid knowledge of lighting and electrical systems.
